Location: Dhaka (now in Bangladesh)

- Context: The founding meeting was held during the All India Muhammadan Educational Conference, which was hosted by Nawab Salimullah Khan.
- Headquarters: Lucknow

2. Founders and Key Figures

- Primary Founder: Nawab Salimullah Khan of Dhaka
- Key Founders & Leadership:
 - Agha Khan III: Key founder and the first President of the league.
 - Nawab Waqar-ul-Mulk and Nawab Mohsan-ul-Mulk: Served as the secretaries of the founding conference.

3. Early Meetings and Sessions

- 1907 (First Annual Session): Held in Karachi on December 29, 1907, chaired by Adamji Peer Bhai.
- 1908 (Second Annual Session): Held in Amritsar.
- Regular Conventions: The league held its annual conventions regularly from its inception, with confirmed sessions in 1907 and 1908.

4. Initial Leadership and Structure

- First President: Agha Khan III
- International Branch:
 - A London branch was established in 1908.
 - President of London Branch: Syed Ameer Ali

5. Early Objectives and Political Stance

- **Primary Objective:** To protect the political rights and interests of Muslims in India.
- Key Stances:
 - Supported the Partition of Bengal (1905).
 - Advocated for separate electorates for Muslims (a demand formally presented to Viceroy Lord Minto in Shimla in 1906).
- Relationship with Congress: It was not founded in opposition to the Indian National Congress at its inception.
