Major Global Sea Routes

Busiest Sea Route

- **Route:** North Atlantic Ocean
- **Reason:** Connects the two major industrial and economically developed regions of North America (U.S.A. and Canada) and Western Europe.

Other Important Sea Routes & Chokepoints

- Suez Canal
- Panama Canal
- Cape of Good Hope (shipping route around South Africa)

Air Routes and Airlines

Flight Path Sequences

1. **Delhi to Tokyo (Onward Journey):** The correct landing sequence is:
 - Hong Kong (1)
 - Hanoi (2)
 - Taipei (3)

- Bangkok (4)
- 2. **Perth to London (Shortest Route):** The shortest air route is:
 - Perth → Aden → Paris → London
- 3. **IC-814 Hijacking (1999):** The flight path, based on airport labels, was:
 - 5 → 4 → 2 → 3

Airlines

- **Lufthansa:** The flag carrier airline of Germany.

Major Global Railway Networks

Trans-Siberian Railway (Russia)

- **Description:** One of the world's longest railways.
- **Route:** Runs from Leningrad (St. Petersburg) to Vladivostok.
- **Major Cities on Route:** Kazan, Omsk, Chita.
- **City Not on Route:** Sochi (located on the Black Sea, not on the Trans-Siberian line).

Other Significant Railways

- **European Transcontinental Railway:** Connects major Western European cities (e.g., Paris to Warsaw).
- **Orient Express:** A famous historical route from Paris to Istanbul.
- **Trans-Andean Railway:** Runs from Buenos Aires (Argentina) to Valparaiso (Chile), crossing the Andes mountains.
- **Canadian Pacific Railway:** Runs between Montreal (East) and Vancouver (West).

Notable Tunnels

- **Seikan Tunnel (Japan):** The world's longest railroad tunnel.
- **Euro Tunnel (Channel Tunnel):** A rail tunnel connecting England and France beneath the English Channel.
