Indian Hill Stations & Resorts

Location by State

- **Uttarakhand**
 - Chakrata is a hill station.
 - Auli is a tourist centre.
- **Assam**
 - Haflong is a hill station.
- **West Bengal**
 - Kalimpong is a hill station.
- **Himachal Pradesh**
 - Kufri is a hill station.
 - Kasauli is a tourist centre.
 - Kyelang (in Lahaul Valley) is a tourist centre.
- **Jammu and Kashmir**
 - Gulmarg is a tourist centre.
- **Tamil Nadu**
 - Ooty (Udhagamandalam) is a tourist centre.
- **Karnataka**
 - Chikmagalur is a tourist centre.

South Indian Temple Hills

- The temple of Lord Ranganatha/Venkatesha is located on **Thirumala (Tirupati) Hills**.
- Srisailem, a pilgrimage place, is located in the **Nallamala Hills**.

UNESCO World Heritage Sites in India

- Champaner – Pavagarh Archaeological Park
- Chhatrapati Shivaji Railway Station, Mumbai
- Mamallapuram (Group of Monuments)
- Sun Temple (Konark Temple)

National Parks & Wildlife

- Kanha National Park is famous for its **Tiger** population.

Nicknames of Indian Cities

- Jaipur is known as the **Pink City**.
- Ujjain is known as the **City of Mahakal**.
- Kolkata is known as the **City of Joy**.
- **Correction:** Jaisalmer is **not** correctly matched with 'City of Lakes'. (The 'City of Lakes' is Udaipur).

Pilgrimage Sites

- Sabarimala temple is situated in **Kerala**.
- Pushkar is a pilgrimage place; it is **not** located in the Mahadeo Hills.
- Omkareshwar is a pilgrimage place; it is **not** located in the Satmala Hills.

Ghost Towns

- Kuldhara is a ghost town.
- Dhanushkodi is a ghost town.
- Lakhpat is a ghost town.

- **Note:** Charkhari is **not** typically classified as a major ghost town.

Tourism Campaigns

- The Ministry of Tourism's campaign to promote India is called **Incredible India**.
